It would pair well with a Thanksgiving turkey. venison or chocolate desserts, or make an alluring punch base. Some bartenders mix it with sparkling wine, gin or tequila. Labeled simply Pomegranate, it's about \$10 a bottle in the Wine Store at Whole Foods: Grand Wine & Liquor, 3005 31st Avenue, Astoria, Queens; and Heights Chateau, 123 Atlantic Avenue (Henry Street), Brooklyn Heights.
